Training

The training covers also deckwork and boat information and will give each crew member the skills and knowledge they need to feel safe and proficient with all elements of the boat's equipment.

Life Onboard the “Ocean Breeze”

The “Ocean Breeze” skippers & Co-Skippers have all sailed more than once around the world, so each of them have a broad range of experiences to draw on and share with you. Whether it is tips on what to wear, how to stay clean & fresh or how to set up your bunk so it is as comfy as possible our skippers or our hostess will be there to guide you through the process. We don't want you to merely 'survive' the experience, we want you to really live it!

During the delivery all crew members will be invited to participate as fully as possible with the sailing to get the very best from the delivery. This means you will have every opportunity to helm, trim & work the foredeck for example as well as getting involved in normal everyday shipboard tasks like maintenance & cooking.

Life onboard a the “**Vo70 Ocean Breeze**” is regulated first and foremost by the watch system.

On the “**Ocean Breeze**”, we use a very simple 4 hr system which we have found, is easily understood & adapted to.

What this means for you, as a new crew member, joining any event that includes overnight sailing, is that once we have left port and “**Ocean Breeze**” is starting to settle down into normal sea-going operations, the skipper will divide the crew into two seperate operational groups or 'watches'.

One group will then be 'on watch' and will man the deck, helm the boat, perform deck work as required & their 'watch leader' (either the skipper or a experienced crew member) will be responsible for safe navigation & safe lookout.

Weather Conditions

Learning how to deal with the weather on board the “**Ocean Breeze**” at sea requires a good degree of common sense & the insight of a professional who has already been through the same conditions.

Whether it is the burning heat or winter cold, our professional crew will help you adapt as much as possible.
